## 25 Bell patterns

Suggestions for use:

- 1) Re the distribution of high and low sounds: try other possibilities.
- 2) The commas show possible phrasing, as implied by the high-low sounds; several patterns have more than one good starting point
- 3) The patterns gradually increase in "density" (the number of times the bell is actually struck during the two bars: 7 sounds = pattern 1; 8 sounds = patterns 2-4; 9 sounds = patterns 6-12; 10 sounds = patterns 13, 10; 11 sounds = patterns 20, 24; 12 sounds = patterns 25
- 10 sounds = patterns 13-19; 11 sounds = patterns 20-24; 12 sounds = pattern 25
  4) If playing the partido alto pattern at the same time, the bell patterns sound best with the partido alto in the 4-3 direction; in a few cases, the partido alto can run either way
- 5) Try reversing the order of the bars (in which case the partido alto will also run in the other direction, i.e. 3-4 instead of 4-3.
- 6) Experiment!
